Activities Report

- provided counseling to 200 low income, uninsured or underinsured people in Lane County
- served 250 people with information and referrals to appropriate resources
- presented 8 trainings for professionals providing CEU's
- delivered 2 community presentations on mental health, sexual assault and domestic violence to 80 participants

Expenditures

- supervision \$3000
- salaries \$3000
- materials \$500
- IT support \$1500

2021 Goals Progress

- successfully recruited and trained 25 Master's level interns
- provided immediate services to victims of Holiday Farms fire
- setting up more groups to serve more people
- successfully transitioned to telehealth
